- 3. The Silver Rule says, "Do not do to others what you would not want done to you." What would happen if all our relationships were governed by this rule? What would we be missing?
- 4. Read Luke 6:27-31. What part of Jesus's teaching leading up to the Golden Rule do you find the hardest to live out?
- 5. Why does Jesus say it's not good enough for our relationships or our world to "Do unto others as they have done to you?" (See Luke 6:32-36).
- 6. Remembering that you are a person who is in need of mercy and through Jesus, you've received it, is absolutely necessary if you're going to be able to do good to others, regardless of how they've treated you and to do it first!
